Data

The Dairy Australia Domestic Sales database includes monthly wholesale data for important dairy categories such as milk, butter, cream, cheese and yoghurt. The data contains important dimensions such as sales channel, segment, pack type/size and state.

The Dairy Australia Milk Production database includes monthly volume data for protein, fat and litres of raw milk picked up from suppliers. The data contains pickup states and regions.

The Milk Production database collects data from participating milk processors in Australia, Levies Revenue Services and the State Dairy Authorities.

The Dairy Australia manufactured production database includes monthly production data for important dairy categories such as butter, butteroil, SMP, BMP, cheese, WMP and whey powder from 2000 onwards. The data can be displayed by production state.

International, Trade, Monthly, Categorised, Detail: Medium

Data

The Dairy Australia imports/exports database includes monthly imports/exports volumes and values for nineteen different dairy product categories including but not limited to butter, cheese, milk, SMP, WMP and yoghurt. The time series starts at 1990 and is ongoing.

Source

The Australian Dairy Trade database uses subscription data from the Australian Bureau of Statistics.

International, Trade, Monthly, Categorised, Detail: Medium

Data

The Dairy Australia international trade database includes monthly imports/exports data covering both volume and value for nineteen different dairy product categories and 30 different countries from the year 2000 onwards. The dataset includes important dimensions such as geographic zone and country of export/import.

Source

The International Dairy Trade database uses subscription data from Trade Data Monitor.

The Export Market Dairy Tariffs database includes an annual snapshot of quota, safeguard and tariff rate information for 22 of the most relevant overseas export destinations for the Australian dairy industry.

Data

The Dairy Australia livestock database includes weekly livestock slaughter data (price and head sold) for eight livestock categories from 2003 for Victoria and 2018 onwards for other states. Note that no data is available for Tasmania.

Domestic, Manufacturing, Quarterly, Detail: Medium

Data

The Dairy Australia Who Makes What database contains manufactured dairy categories, brand and product information, as well as contact details for over 230 current dairy manufacturers in Australia.

Source

The Who Makes What database is populated using publicly available data from Australian manufacturers websites and often complemented with details obtained by contacting the manufacturer.

Exchange rates

International, Reference, Daily, Categorised, Detail: Low

Data

The Dairy Australia exchange rate database contains daily exchange rates for AUD, EUR, USD and GBP to about fifty other currencies from 2018 onwards. A limited number of currencies include more historical data.

Source

The exchange rate database uses data from a number of different data sources including but not limited to XE Money and the Reserve Bank of Australia.

Access

Data

The Industry Data Group's environmental dataset contains water prices for selected locations, dam levels for selected sites in Australia, rainfall and thermal heat index data for Australian dairy farm locations.

Source

The environmental data is based on publicly available data from the Victorian Water Register and Murray Irrigation.
