

HOW TO PREPARE YOUR SILAGE WRAP FOR RECYCLING

Farmers need to take some simple steps:

- Just like with a yellow bin recycling system, for silage plastics recycling to work effectively, you need to keep the plastic free of contaminants
- We use recycling bins with a clear liner so that the used plastics can be contained and recyclers can check for contamination. (The liners are made of the same type of plastic as the bale wrap so it can all be recycled together.)

Step 1:



Place the liner in the bin and ensure there is plenty of overhang to tie the liner off when filled.

Step 2:



Separate the bale wrap from the net wrap. Set the net wrap aside (**this is not recyclable**) and shake off excess dirt from bale wrap.

Step 3:



Tightly roll the plastic and pack firmly in bin liner.

Step 4:



Once bin is full, tie off with plastic (do not use metal wire) and set aside for drop off or collection.

YES ✓ Silage plastic

NO ✗ Net wrap, twine, rocks, metal, other plastics/waste, dead animals!
